Let's see what John has to say in Revelation 21: 1-4. Now I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth has passed away.

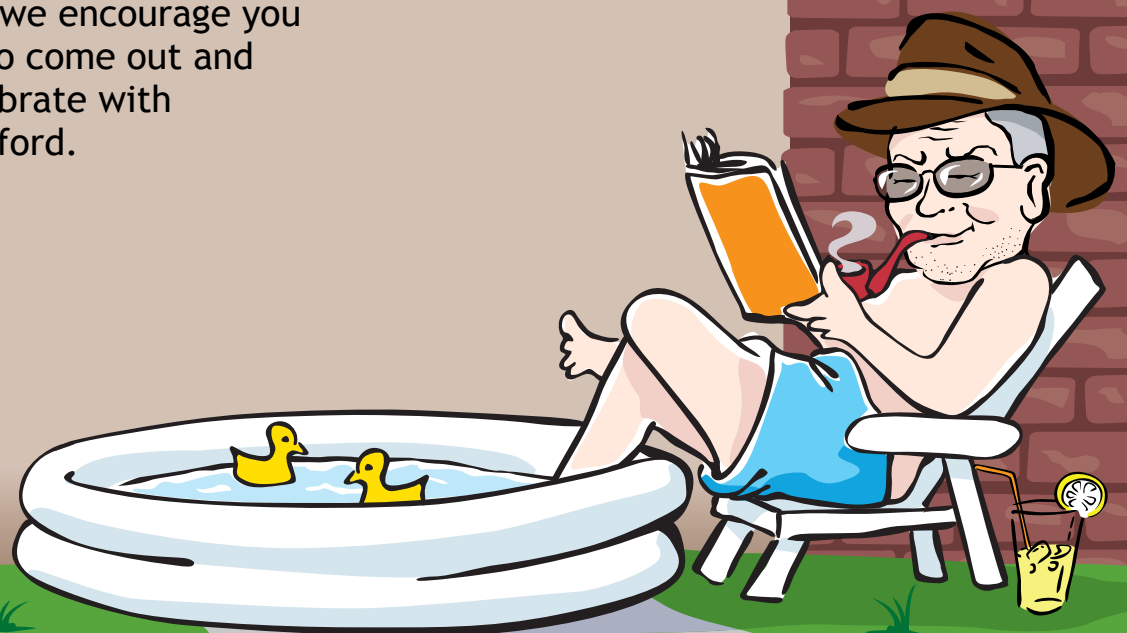
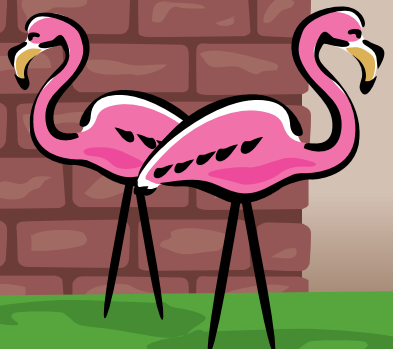


A friendly message from our Intern!

During the Wild West days in Billings, Montana, the cowboys and scarlet ladies of every saloon performed impossible dances atop bars, tables, and in some instances upon atop the pianos.

Cowboys often worked on cattle drives. This was when a large herd of cattle was moved from the ranch to a market where they could be sold. A lot of the original cattle drives went from Texas to the railroads in Kansas.

The Rodeo became a sports competition with events based around the daily jobs of a cowboy. Events include calf roping, steer wrestling, bull riding, bareback bronco riding, and barrel racing.

The most important possession of any cowboy was his horse and saddle. The horse was probably the most valuable item a cowboy owned.
