


## ~\* ~ Chaplain's Chat ~\*~

Cowboys often worked on cattle drives. This was when a large herd of cattle was moved from the ranch to a market where they could be sold. Alot of the original cattle drives went from Texas to the railroads in Kansas.

The Rodeo became a sports competition with events based around the daily jobs of a cowboy. Events include calf roping, steer wrestling, bull riding, bareback bronco riding, and barrel racing.
