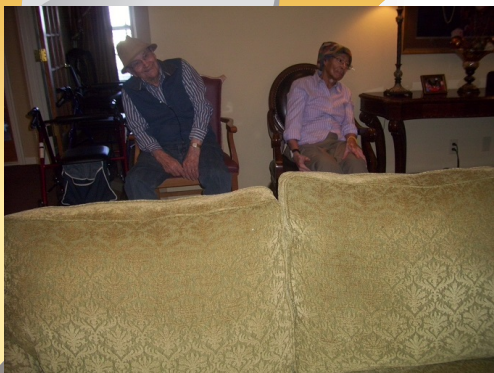

The history of Veterans Day

On the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month of 1918, an armistice, or temporary cessation of hostilities, was declared between the Allied nations and Germany in WWI, then known as the "Great War". This day was commemorated as Armistice Day the following year (1919). All business stopped for two minutes in honor of this day.

On June 4, 1926, Congress officially recognized the end of WWI when it passed a concurrent resolution. November 11 became a legal federal holiday in the U.S. in 1938.

After WWII and the Korean War Armistice Day became Veterans Day, a holiday dedicated

to American veterans of all wars. President Dwight D. Eisenhower signed legislation in 1954 declaring November 11 Veterans' Day in honor of American veterans of all wars.

There are more than 21.2 million veterans in the U.S. according to the Census Bureau.

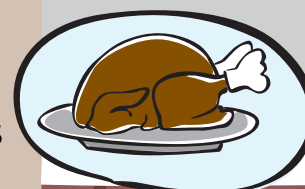
Approximately 42% of the U.S. veterans are over the age of 65.
