As we prepare to 'spring forward' and adjust our clocks on March 11, here are some interesting facts you may not have known about daylight saving time.

- 1. It's daylight 'saving' time, not 'savings' time. The word 'saving' acts as part of an adjective, not a verb; the singular form is correct.
- 2. Although he favored maximizing daylight working hours, Benjamin Franklin did not originate the idea of moving clocks forward.
- 3. Germany was the ist country to enact vlight saving time. It gar during wartime conserve energy and s later referred to as 'summer time" after other countries had also adopted the idea.
- 4. Daylight saving time was not intended to benefit farmers, as many people believe. American farmers did not lobby for it to have more time to work in the fields. Actually, the agriculture industry was extremely opposed to it. The sun, not the clock, dicated farmers' schedules, so daylight saving time was disruptive. Farmers had to wait an extra hour for dew to evaporate to harvest hay, hired hands worked less since they still left at the same time for dinner and cows were not ready to be milked an hour earlier to meet shipping schedules.
- 5. Not everyone in the U.S. springs forward and falls back. Hawaii, Arizona and some Amish communities choose not to participate in dayight saving time.
