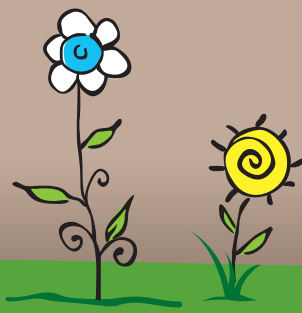
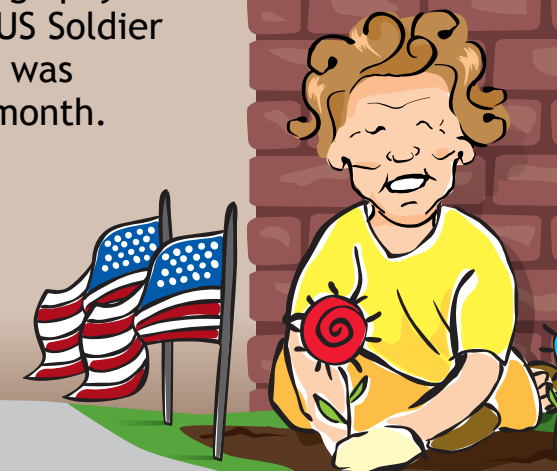
Originally, Memorial Day was known as Decoration Day, meant to honor the Union and the Confederate soldiers who died during the American Civil War. By the 1900's, it had become a day to celebrate all American soldiers who died while serving in the military. It wasn't until 1967 that it was legally named, Memorial Day.

1. Major General John A. Logan made Memorial Day Official.

2. Arlington National Cemetery contains the remains of over 400,000 people.

3. It is estimated that over 15 million people lost their life during WWII, over 400,000 were US Soldiers.

4. The average pay for an enlisted US Soldier during WWII was \$71.33 per month.
