* The very first St. Patrick's Day parade was not in Ireland. It was in Boston in 1737.

* The city of Chicago goes so far to celebrate that they dye their river green.

* Green is associated with St. Patrick's Day because it is the color of spring, of Ireland and of the shamrock.

* In 1948 President Truman became the first president to attend a St. Patrick's Day parade.

* The largest parade in the United States, since 1762, is in New York City, and draws more than one million spectators each year.

* Over 100 U.S. cities hold a parade every year. Some of the other biggest St. Patrick's Day parades are in the cities of Chicago and Savannah.

* There are 33. million U.S. residents who are of Irish ancestry. That number is almost nine times the population of Ireland itself.
