Getting the best out of vour tooth brush Brushing and flossing is the best way to protect your teeth and gums-but not if your toothbrush is in bad shape. Toothbrush bristles that are worn or effectively remove plague, which is critical to maintaining healthy teeth and gums.

Some advice: *Don't cover up brushes between uses. Allow them to air-dry instead. This method will lessen the growth of bacteria. *Rinse them thoroughly. After each use rinse them under running water until all remaining toothpaste is cleaned off.

*Store them in an upright position to best air them out.

* Replace them often. Get asnew brush at least every 3 highths.
